

YOUTH VENDOR GUIDELINES:

- All items must be created and handmade by the youth applicant (no craft kits).
- Food items must be low risk and be prepared, packaged, and handled in accordance with BC Market Safe Guidelines (bcfarmersmarket.org).
- Youth vendor tables must be primarily run by the child participating.
- Youth vendors must be accompanied by an adult during the set-up, duration of the market and take down.



WHAT CAN MY KID SELL?

Popular ideas include jewelry, bracelets, earrings, slime kits, painted rocks, bookmarks and cards, key chains and charms, Christmas ornaments and stocking stuffers, suncatchers, hair accessories, original art, and more. Try to be unique, as we often have many Christmas-baking Kidpreneurs.

BE PREPARED ON MARKET NIGHT:

- Bring your own float you will need coins and bills.
- Bring a notebook, pencil and calculator to help you count back change.
- Plan ahead how you want to display and decorate your table. Do you need boxes, etc to create height?

WE PROVIDE:

- We provide a shared table, white plastic tablecloth, and 1 chair.
- Spaces are W=3" x D= 29" (standard 6 ft table shared between 2 kidpreneurs)
- Due to space limitations, only 1 kid vendor per space.





- All signage will need to be infront of, or on your table.
- Make it easy for customers to buy your products—use price labels or a clearly displayed price list. Place them in picture frames to keep your table neat!
- Does your product need packaging? If your child enjoys drawing, adding a picture and attractive packaging can help make your product 'gift-ready'.

DAY OF MARKET SETUP:

- · Vendor Set Up: Anytime after 4PM on Friday
- There are 2 parking lots at the school, as well as overflow parking along the road, and also at Connor Park.
- The gym has 2 sets of double doors that open to the parking lot for easy loading / unloading.
- Please have kid tables complete and ready to go for opening at 5:30PM

WHAT IS KIDPRENEUR CASH?

- The first 300 attendees will receive \$1 in 'Kidpreneur Cash'! This special cash can only be spent with our young vendors, giving them a boost in sales.
- Please treat 'Kidpreneur Cash' like real money—no change will be given.
